

**E50 - WHAT HAPPENS WHEN WE DIE**

1. (Deuteronomy 32:22 KJV) For a fire is kindled in mine anger, and shall burn unto the lowest hell, and shall consume the earth with her increase, and set on fire the foundations of the mountains.
2. (Ezekiel 26:20 KJV) When I shall bring thee down with them that descend into the pit, with the people of old time, and shall set thee in the low parts of the earth, in places desolate of old, with them that go down to the pit, that thou be not inhabited; and I shall set glory in the land of the living;
3. (Amos 9:2 KJV) Though they dig into hell, thence shall mine hand take them; though they climb up to heaven, thence will I bring them down:
4. (Genesis 25:8 KJV) Then Abraham gave up the ghost, and died in a good old age, an old man, and full *of years*; and was gathered to his people.
5. (2 Samuel 12:23 KJV) But now he is dead, wherefore should I fast? can I bring him back again? I shall go to him, but he shall not return to me.
6. (Isaiah 14:4-10 KJV) That thou shalt take up this proverb against the king of Babylon, and say, How hath the oppressor ceased! the golden city ceased! {5} The LORD hath broken the staff of the wicked, *and* the sceptre of the rulers. {6} He who smote the people in wrath with a continual stroke, he that ruled the nations in anger, is persecuted, *and* none hindereth. {7} The whole earth is at rest, *and* is quiet: they break forth into singing. {8} Yea, the fir trees rejoice at thee, *and* the cedars of Lebanon, *saying*, Since thou art laid down, no feller is come up against us. {9} Hell from beneath is moved for thee to meet *thee* at thy coming: it stirreth up the dead for thee, *even* all the chief ones of the earth; it hath raised up from their thrones all the kings of the nations. {10} All they shall speak and say unto thee, Art thou also become weak as we? art thou become like unto us?
7. (Isaiah 5:14 KJV) Therefore hell hath enlarged herself, and opened her mouth without measure: and their glory, and their multitude, and their pomp, and he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it.
8. (Hebrews 4:12 KJV) For the word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
9. (1 Thessalonians 5:23 KJV) And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and *I pray God*

your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

10. (James 2:26 KJV) For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

11. (Ecclesiastes 12:7 KJV) Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it.

12. (1 Kings 17:20-22 KJV) And he cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, hast thou also brought evil upon the widow with whom I sojourn, by slaying her son? {21} And he stretched himself upon the child three times, and cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, I pray thee, let this child's soul come into him again. {22} And the LORD heard the voice of Elijah; and the soul of the child came into him again, and he revived.

13. (Acts 7:59 KJV) And they stoned Stephen, calling upon *God*, and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.

14. (Luke 23:43 KJV) And Jesus said unto him, **Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with me in paradise.**

15. (Revelation 6:9-11 KJV) And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: {10} And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth? {11} And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they *were*, should be fulfilled.

16. (Hebrews 12:22-23 KJV) But ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels, {23} To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect,

17. (2 Corinthians 5:6-8 KJV) Therefore *we are* always confident, knowing that, whilst we are at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord: {7} (For we walk by faith, not by sight:) {8} We are confident, *I say*, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

18. (Philippians 1:21-23 KJV) For to me to live *is* Christ, and to die *is* gain. {22} But if I live in the flesh, this *is* the fruit of my labour: yet what I shall choose I wot not. {23} For I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better:

19. (2 Corinthians 12:2-4 KJV) I knew a man in Christ above fourteen years ago, (whether in the body, I cannot tell; or whether out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;) such an one

caught up to the third heaven. {3} And I knew such a man, (whether in the body, or out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;) {4} How that he was caught up into paradise, and heard unspeakable words, which it is not lawful for a man to utter.

20. (Ephesians 4:8-10 KJV) Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men. {9} (Now that he ascended, what is it but that he also descended first into the lower parts of the earth? {10} He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that he might fill all things.)

21. (Matthew 12:40 KJV) **For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.**

22. (Acts 2:31 KJV) He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption.

23. (1 Peter 4:6 KJV) For for this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit.

(24. Acts 24:15 KJV) And have hope toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust.

25. (Revelation 20:11-14 KJV) And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. {12} And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. {13} And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. {14} And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

26. (Matthew 10:28 KJV) **And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.**

27. (Mark 9:47-48 KJV) **And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for thee to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire: {48} Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.**
