

Time Line for 1,000 Year Reign - When Is it?

Does the 1,000 year reign take place in Heaven or on Earth?

Revelation 20:4

(4) And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and *I saw* the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received *his* mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

The phrase “thousand years” is repeatedly used symbolically.

Psalms 90:4

(4) For a thousand years in thy sight *are but* as yesterday when it is past, and *as* a watch in the night.

2 Peter 3:8

(8) But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day *is* with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

Ecclesiastes 6:6

(6) Yea, though he live a thousand years twice *told*, yet hath he seen no good: do not all go to one place?

Psalms 50:10

(10) For every beast of the forest *is* mine, *and* the cattle upon a thousand hills.

Psalms 105:8-10

(8) He hath remembered his covenant for ever, the word *which* he commanded to a thousand generations.

(9) Which *covenant* he made with Abraham, and his oath unto Isaac;

(10) And confirmed the same unto Jacob for a law, *and* to Israel *for* an everlasting covenant:

Jesus ascends to the Right Hand of the Father to sit on David’s throne.

Acts 2:29-33

(29) Men *and* brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day.

(30) Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his throne;

(31) He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption.

(32) This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.

(33) Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

Jesus Reigns on David’s throne until Death is destroyed.

1 Corinthians 15:25-26

(25) For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.

(26) The last enemy *that* shall be destroyed *is* death.

1 Corinthians 15:52-55

(52) In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

(53) For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal *must* put on immortality.

(54) So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

(55) O death, where *is* thy sting? O grave, where *is* thy victory?

Why didn’t Paul say how long Jesus would reign on David’s throne?

Matthew 24:36

(36) But of that day and hour knoweth no *man*, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only.

The First Resurrection takes place when We are Born Again

Colossians 3:1

(1) If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.

Ephesians 2:5-6

(5) Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)

(6) And hath raised *us* up together, and made *us* sit together in heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus:

Luke 15:24

(24) For this my son was dead, and is alive again; he was lost, and is found. And they began to be merry.

Romans 6:5

(5) For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also *in the likeness of his* resurrection:

Jesus Returns

To Raise the dead

John 5:28-29

(28) Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice,

(29) And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

Acts 24:15

(15) And have hope toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust.

Daniel 12:2

(2) And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame *and* everlasting contempt.

1 Thessalonians 4:16-18

(16) For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

(17) Then we which are alive *and* remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

(18) Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

To hold Judgment

2 Timothy 4:1

(1) I charge *thee* therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom;

Matthew 25:31-34

(31) When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory:

(32) And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth *his* sheep from the goats:

(33) And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left.

(34) Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

1 Corinthians 15:50

(50) Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

Revelation 20:11

(11) And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

To Restore the New Heavens and the New Earth.

2 Peter 3:8-13

(8) But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day *is* with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

(9) The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

(10) But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

(11) *Seeing* then *that* all these things shall be dissolved, what manner *of persons* ought ye to be in *all* holy conversation and godliness,

(12) Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?

(13) Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

Isaiah Chapters 65 & 66 are talking about The New Heavens and the New Earth

Isaiah 65:17

(17) For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth: and the former shall not be remembered, nor come into mind.

Isaiah 66:22

(22) For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain.

The Resurrection and the Judgment both take place on the Last Day.

John 11:24

(24) Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day.

John 6:39

(39) And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.

John 12:48

(48) He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.

When Jesus Returns, He will reign forever and ever.

Revelation 11:15

(15) And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become *the kingdoms* of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.
